Be it ordered by the court that the Peoples State Bank of Bonson, be discontinued as County Depository upon the reorganization of the First National Bank of Memphis, which is hereby designated special depository, when the bond of said bank shall have been duly provided by the County and State departments. The contract of special depository with The First National Bank of Bonson, is hereby cancelled.  
That the Tax Collector of Sabine County be authorized to accept taxes from W. P. Avera upon his Bonson Lots, at the same valuation as last year or \$900.00. It met being the intention of the Board of equalization to raise the value for \$1050.00.
