

The Hon. Commissioner's court met in regular session, March 9th, 1931, with all members present, to wit: R. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McTown, Commissioner Prec. No. 1, N. E. McDaniel, Commissioner Prec. No. 2, W. R. Low, Commissioner Prec. No. 3 & J. E. Minton, Commissioner of Prec. No. 4, Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, and E. B. Smith, sheriff, and transacted the following business.

On motion of E. J. McTown, 2nd by N. E. McDaniel, the January report of Tex Collector, Ross Fenner, was approved.

It was also ordered by the court that the Watson Children, whose given names are: Luther, Alton -----, and Al B., and who were heretofore, to-wit: on the 7th day of March 1931, duly adjudged by the District Court, to be delinquent and neglected children, the State home for such children having refused to accept them, the sheriff of this county is now instructed and authorized to place these children in homes of suitable moral and social environment, in order that the County may be relieved of their care, until other arrangements can be made.

It is further ordered by the court that the salary of the Janitor be reduced from \$50.00 to \$40.00 per month, effective April 1st, 1931.

No further business at this time, court is adjourned.
