

The Commissioners Court, in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Special Session, April 6th, 1931, at the regular meeting place thereof, with the following members present to-wit: A. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McEown, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, N. E. McDaniel, Commissioner of Precinct No. 2, _____, Commissioner Precinct No. 3, J. E. Minton, Commissioner Precinct No. 4, Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk and transacted business as follows:

Whereas, there appears to be a necessity for a re-check of Finance of all Common School Districts, as well as independent districts, with scholastic population less than five hundred

And, whereas, this meeting of the court was held in conjunction with the Board of County School Trustees, being a joint session, of the two bodies, and both being of the same opinion in regard to an audit of County School funds.

Therefore be it ordered by the court, that the County Treasurer be authorized and directed to check the common School District, receipts and disbursements, from all courses, for three years back and whatever greater length of time, would seem necessary, to determine whether or not vouchers issued during this space of time have been duly cancelled and if not report the number and amount of vouchers cancelled or unaccounted for, according to the approved list on the books of the County Superintendent, for the space of time included in such investigation.

Be it also ordered by the court that the County Treasurer be authorized and directed to demand from the present County Depository, First National Bank, in Memphis, the cancelled vouchers also a list of unpaid vouchers, either in the bank or by whomsoever carried, belonging to every common School district in said County. Said motion having been made by E. J. McEown, second by N. E. McDaniel, and carried by a unanimous vote.

No further business coming before the court, at this time, the meeting was declared adjourned.
