On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that the road from Brookeland at Mr. Lou Hells place, to San Augustine, County, via. of Needmore, be classed as a first class road.

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that the upkeep of the Long bridge, across bear creek, botton, on the road leading from Brookeland, to Bronson-Front, in San Augustine, County, be discontinued, and that at such time as County conditions and other circumstances will permit it will be torn down and short bridges constructed where absolutely necessary, upon condition that persons interested will contribute labor and terms sufficient to make such repairs as might be considered absolutely necessary.

Accounts were allowed as per account ledger.
