

On this the 20th day of May, the Commissioners' court sitting as a board of Equalization after having been in session five days, is adjourned as a board of equalization until the 11th day of June, at 9 o'clock A.M. at which time all hearing will be heard by the court of parties who desire to show cause, if any they can, why raises, if any, on their values should be imposed on property rendered by them, for tax purposes for the year 1932.

The County Clerk, is authorized and directed to give all parties whose values have been raised at least 10 days notice of said raise, and notice of the fact that the court will reconvene as a board of equalization to hear said reasons, if any, of any persons seeking to show cause why their value should not be raised, and requesting all parties to appear from the 11th day of June, up to and including the 13th day of June, 1931, during which time all hearing will be had.

Taxes are levied for purposes and in amounts for the year 1932, as follows: An occupation tax, as provided by Article 7048, R.C.S. providing for such levy, the amount available to the County, being one-half of the occupation levied by the State of Texas, upon all occupations not herein, otherwise, specially exempted.

The County Treasurer, is ordered and directed to set aside 6 1/2% respectively of the road and bridge levy of 1931, to the credit of the road and Bridge Funding Warrant fund or as much thereof, as may be necessary to care for maturing warrants, and accrued interest for the current year, this applies to Road and Bridge Funding Warrant fund, Class No. 3 and 4, Also that 6% and 5% respectively of the 25% General County levy of 1931, be set aside to the general county fund, Class 4, or as much thereof, as may be necessary to care for maturing warrants and interest for the current year. Also that 2 1/2% of the 15% Road and Bridge levy of 1931, be set aside to the credit of the Bridge Repair Bond fund, or as much thereof, as is necessary to care for maturing warrants and approved interest for the current year.

There is hereby levied for the year 1931 upon all taxable property in Common School District

No. 12, 19, 23, 24 and 28, of this County on the first day of January of the current year, the following taxes; And advalorem tax of, and at the rate of \$.50 on the \$100.00 valuation in said district, to supplement the State School funds, apportioned to said Districts for the support and maintenance of Public schools.

That there is hereby levied for the year 1931, on all taxable property in common school Districts No. 2, 5, 8, 9, 11, 14, 15, 16, 20, 25, 27, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, and 37 of the County on the 1st day of current year the following taxes; An advalorem tax of and at the rate of \$.75 on the \$100.00 valuation, in said district to supplement the State School fund apportioned to said District for the support and maintenance of the public school.

That there is hereby levied for the year 1931, on all taxable property in Common School Districts No. 3, 5, 17, 26, 30 & 28, of this County on the 1st day of January of the current year the following taxes an advalorem tax of and at the rate of one dollar on the one hundred dollar valuation in said districts to supplement the State School Fund apportioned to said District for the support and maintenance of public schools.

That there is hereby levied for the year 1931, on all taxable property in common School Districts No. 14, 16, 17, 20 and 31, of this County, an advalorem tax of and at the rate of 10, 30, 32 & 40, 43, 45, 52 and 65 cents, respectively on the \$100.00 valuation in said districts to pay current interest on and provided for one years sinking fund for the bonds of said district.

That there is hereby levied a county occupation tax, for the year 1931, at the rate of (1/2) one cent, of the amount of occupation levied by the State of Texas, upon all the occupations as same in article no. 7047 Civil Statutes, and provided further that any provisions of said law shall not be deemed to affect the provisions of any law specially authorizing the Commissioners Court to levy a different rate of tax.
