A contract was entered into with J. R. Phillips Investment Company, providing for the refund of outstanding script and warrants, into Road and Bridge Refunding Bonds, on motion of J. E. Minton, 2nd by E. J. McGown, it is ordered by the court that \$1800.00 against the road and bridge fund, be allowed, H. C. Durt, and Company in full satisfaction of his share in such contract, and the termination of this contract on record.

No further business coming on to be considered at this time, court was declared adjourned.

On this the 10 day of June, 1931, the Commissioners' court of Sabine County, Texas, convened in regular meeting at a regular term thereof with the following members to the court present, to-wit:

R. H. Dent, County Judge. E. J. McGown, Commissioner Precinct No. 1. N. E. McDaniel, Commissioner Precinct No. 2. W. R. Low, Commissioner Precinct No. 3, J. E. Minton, Commissioner Precinct No. 4. Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, and Ex-officio Clerk, Commissioners' court, constituting the entire court, at which time the Judge presented for consideration an order.

Commissioners E. J. McGown, moved that the order be passed. The motion was seconded by Commissioner E. J. Minton, and the motion was carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Commissioners McGown, McDaniel, Low and Minton.

Noes: None.

The Judge announced that the order had been passed.

The order is as follows:

AN ORDER:

BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SABINE COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SABINE COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE FUNDING BONDS, SERIES 1931, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$71,000.00, BEARING 6% INTEREST, PROVIDING FOR THE EXCHANGE IN LIEU THEREOF OF CERT. IN WARRANTS OF THE COUNTY OUTSTANDING AS LEGAL INDEBTEDNESS ON MAY 21, 1931, LEVYING A TAX TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST OF SAID BONDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, on May 21, 1931, the date house Bill 312 passed by the Regular Session of the forty-second Legislature became affected, there was outstanding certain legal indebtedness of said county chargeable against its road and bridge fund, represented by interest-bearing time warrants and script warrants theretofore issued by said county; and

whereas, said indebtedness consists of (1) interest-bearing time warrants and bonds, and (2) script warrants, hereinafter set forth;

(1) INTEREST-BEARING TIME WARRANTS, AND BONDS.

(a) Interest-bearing time warrants, designated "Sabine County Road & Bridge Warrants," dated the 10th day of April 1923, bearing 6% interest, of the denomination of \$1000.00 each, numbered 2 to 5 inclusive, aggregating \$4,000.00, maturing serially in their numerical order \$1000 each year 1932, 1933, 1934 and 1935.

(b) Interest-bearing time warrants designated "Sabine County Road & Bridge Warrants"; dated the 15th day of May, 1928, bearing 6% interest, of the denomination of \$1000 each.

numbered 5 to 30 inclusive, aggregating \$28,000.00, maturing serially in their numerical order as follows: \$1000.00 in each of the years 1936, 1937 and 1938; \$2000.00 in each of the years 1939 to 1942 inclusive; \$3000 in each of the years 1944 to 1948 inclusive;

(c) Interest-bearing time warrants designated "Sabine County _____ Warrants" dated the 10th day of October 1929, bearing 6% interest, numbered 2, 3 and 4, numbers 2 and 3 being on the denomination of \$1000 each, and number 4 being in the denomination of \$651.00, aggregating 2,651.00, maturing \$1000, 1931, \$1000 1932, and \$651.00, 1933.

(d) Bonds designated "Sabine County Bridge Repair bonds, series "A", dated the 14th day of December, 1925, bearing 6% interest, numbered 1 to 4 inclusive, number 1 being of the denomination of \$495.00, and numbered 2, 3 and 4 of the denomination of \$500 each, aggregating 1,995.00 maturing April 10, 1936.

(e) Bonds designated "Sabine County Bridge Repair Bonds, Series B", dated the 15th day of December, 1925, bearing 6% interest, numbered 1 to 4 inclusive, of the denomination of \$500 each except #1, for \$495.00 aggregating \$1,995.00 and maturing April 10, 1937.

(f) Bonds designated "Sabine County Bridge Repair bonds, Series C" dated the 16th day of December, 1925, bearing 6% interest, numbered 1 to 4 inclusive, of the denomination of \$500 each except #1, for \$495, aggregating 1,995.00 and maturing April 10, 1938.

Total of outstanding warrants and bonds, ----- \$40,656.00.

Whereas, all of said interest-bearing time warrants and the original scrip warrants on which they were based were issued in all particulars in accordance with law, including R.C.S. Art. 2368, and the various provisions of the law applicable thereto; and

Whereas, all of said bonds were issued in accordance with the provisions of law applicable thereto; and

(a) CONCERNING SCRIP WARRANTS:

Whereas, certain scrip warrants were outstanding as legal indebtedness against said Road & Bridge Fund of said County on May 31, 1931, and are now outstanding legal indebtedness against said fund; and

Whereas, in each instance where the item of scrip is in excess of \$2,000.00, the contract furnishing the basis of said expenditure was first submitted to competitive bids after prior notice of publication as requested by law, and was awarded upon competitive bids at a regular term of court, except where any one of said items of scrip represents the aggregate amount of separate and independent contracts of purchase of material and the performance of labor, such warrants being issued to cover the aggregate total and in each instance where the item of scrip is in excess of \$500.00 and less than \$2,000.00 the contract furnishing the basis of said expenditures was first submitted to competitive bids and said contract was awarded upon competitive bids at a regular term of court, except in those instances where said scrip represented expenditure for work done under the immediate supervision of the Commissioners' court and paid for by the day, and in those instances where the items of scrip are for more than \$500.00 and where there were no competitive bids as described above, said warrants represent the indebtedness for several distinct transactions or contracts, the amount of no item or contract being in excess of \$500.00, thus issued in compliance with Article 2368 et seq, Revised Statutes of 1925, as in effect prior to May 21, 1931; and

Whereas, the court has determined that the scrip thus issued and outstanding does not exceed in any one of the years the contemplated revenue for either or any of said years; and

Whereas, said scrip outstanding against the Road and Bridge Fund of the County is described as follows:

SECTION 2. That said bonds shall be numbered consecutively from 1 to 71, inclusive; shall be of the denomination of \$1000.00 each, and shall become due and payable as follows:

The Comptroller shall not register said bonds except as and when there shall be surrendered to him said warrants aggregating in amounts the respective amounts of the bonds then to be registered. The holder or holders of said original indebtedness shall be entitled to the accrued interest of the funding bonds, as compensation for not drawing interest on the funding bonds, as compensation for not drawing interest on the original warrants and bonds beyond the date calculated in this ordinance.

Section 12. The Comptroller is authorized to accept from J. R. Phillips Investment Company of Houston, Texas, or upon its order, the original items of indebtedness, and is authorized to deliver to the said J. R. Phillips Investment Company, or upon its order, said funding bonds as and when issued, in accordance with written instructions to be given by the County Judge.

Section 13. That to pay the interest on said bonds and to create a sinking fund sufficient to discharge them as they mature, a tax of eleven (11%) cents on the one hundred dollars assessed valuation of all taxable property in the County of Sabine, is hereby levied for the year 1931, out of the constitutional fifteen (15) cents road and bridge fund of said County, and said tax shall be assessed and collected, and there shall be calculated each year, while any of said bonds are outstanding and unpaid, whatever rate of tax is necessary to provide current interest and the requested amount of the principal for such year, or a proportionate part thereof, and a tax at such rate on the one hundred dollars' valuation of property, and within the rates permitted by the constitution, shall be levied, assessed and collected during each of said years, and said tax is hereby levied, ordered to be levied, assessed and collected and the taxes levied and collected shall be applied to said purpose and to no other purpose.

It is further adjudged and decreed that all things required to be done by law in the issuance of said original warrants funded herein have happened and been performed in due time, form and manner as required by law; that the county received full and lawful value for all of said warrants funded hereby; that all acts heretofore performed by the commissioners' court and by the several county officials in reference thereto are hereby expressly ratified, and said original warrants are hereby ratified; that all acts required by law and all things required by law to have happened, in reference to this issue of funding bonds have happened and been performed in due time, form, and manner as required by law; that this finding is made for the benefit of the prospective holders of said bonds, and for the benefit of the attorney general of Texas.

All receipts listed herein are the figures furnished by the State Department of Education and the Sabine County Tax Collector, and the County Superintendents of adjacent counties. In the matter of County Available receipts I find the County Superintendent and the bank in accord so I have accepted these amounts as true, except in cases where the bank did not give any credit

Pratt's Grocery Company, for roll of wire, \$5.00, after conversation, with several citizens of the Yellowpine District, they inform me that the wire was not purchased for that District, and the best information which I was able to obtain is that it is the same wire which was charged to Dist. No. 8, before it was consolidated with Yellowpine.

Excepted upon statement of N.E. Clark, that he has not drawn that amount from lumber, etc., and of his own personal knowledge no one else has furnished lumber for this school within the last several years, amounting to \$77.98. The initials (N.E.C) were inclosed in brackets upon the charge, and it is supposed that the initials referred to N.E. Clark.

No. 17. J.E. Chambers, Furniture Co., Desks, etc., \$567.67.

Excepted to upon written statement of Mr. *W.J. Harris & W.B. Fuller*. This item is charged in the Building Fund and also in the Local Maintenance fund.

\$70.38 was charged, and according to books of Mr. J.P. McGown, Local Agent, this account was created during the school year of 1925-1926, and upon advice from him that same had been paid. It seems that the charge \$59.83 should have been made, as his books show the renewal of the old policy to be for that amount, and the contention is that the overcharge is the difference between \$70.38, the old premium, and the renewal premium, \$59.83, which difference is \$10.55.
