

The Commissioner's Court met in regular session, July 13th, 1931, with the following members present to-wit: R. H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McEown, Commr. Prect. No. 1, N. E. McDaniel, Commr. Prect. No. 2, W. R. Low, Commr. Prect. No. 3, J. E. Minton, Commr. Prect. No. 4, and Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, and transacted business as follows:

Whereas, County officials whose salaries are payable out of General County Funds are prevented from receiving any remuneration therefrom due to Constitutional limitations, and whereas it is impossible to serve in any useful capacity without remunerations,

Therefore, be it ordered by the court that the following officers be allowed the amount opposite their names as compensation for June and July, out of the Jury Fund,

Mrs. Berta Harper,	150.00
R.H. Dent,	250.00
W.R. Hyden,	100.00
F.S. Goen,	186.00
E.B. Smith,	186.00
A.G. Pratt, part commission	150.00
Co. Board of trustees who have served for the last three meetings of such board, each time, \$3.00, or a total of	9.00 each.

The above amount aggregating approximately \$1050.00, which shall operate as a loan against the Jury Fund and is to be repaid from the General County Fund, at such times as revenues accrue sufficient to make such reimbursement.

2nd. It is ordered by the court that Grover Eddings be issued duplicate Warrant for No. _____, date _____, registerer No. _____ against the Gen. Co. fund, in the amount of \$3.00, for holding General Election, in Vo. 1930; he having lost the original warrant. This duplicate is issued only on condition that should the original again reappear the payee, Mr. Eddings shall be responsible to the County for any loss occasioned herein.

The resignation of J.L. Ludlow, as Justice of the Peace, of Precinct No. 3, was presented to the court and by motion and second duly made and carried the resignation was accepted, although by motion and second it is ordered that E. L. Dean be appointed to fill the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of Mr. Ludlow, Mr. Dean having made bond in the required amount and his bond is approved.

There being no further business, court adjourned.
