constituting the entire court, at which time the Judge presented for consideration an order, commissioner, E. J. McGown, moved that the order be passed. The motion was Seconded by Commissioner N. E. McDaniel, and the motion was carried by the following vote;

AYES: Commissioners McGown, McDaniel, Low and Minton,

NOES: None.

The Judge announced that the order had been passed; The order is as follows:

AN ORDER

BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SABINE COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SABINE COUNTY ROAD AND BRIDGE FUNDING BONDS, SERIES 1931, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$72,800.00, BEARING 6% INTEREST PROVIDING FOR THE EXCHANGE IN LIEU THEREOF CERTAIN WARRANTS OF THE COUNTY OUTSTANDING AS LEGAL INDEBTEDNESS ON MAY 21, 1931, LEVYING A TAX TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST OF SAID BONDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY;

Whereas, on May 21, 1931, the date House Bill 312, passed by the regular Session of the forty-second legislature became effective, there was outstanding certain legal indebtedness of said County chargeable against its Road and Bridge Fund, represented by interest-bearing time warrants and scrip warrants theretofore issued by said County; and

Whereas, said indebtedness consists of, (1) interest-bearing time warrants and bonds, and (2) scrip warrants, hereinafter set forth;

(1). INTEREST-BEARING TIME WARRANTS, AND BONDS;

(a) Interest-bearing time warrants designated "Sabine County Road & Bridge Warrants" dated the 10th day of April, 1923, bearing 6% interest of the denomination of \$1000.00 each, numbered 2 to 5 inclusive, aggregating 4,000.00, maturing serially in their numerical order, \$1000. each year, 1932, 1933, 1934 and 1935.

(b) Interest-bearing time warrants designated "Sabine County Road & Bridge Warrants", dated the 15th day of May, 1928, bearing 6% interest, of the denomination of \$1000.00 each, numbered 3 to 30 inclusive, aggregating 28,000.00, maturing serially in their numerical order as follows: \$1000.00 in each of the years 1936, 1937 and 1938. \$2000.00 in each of the years 1939 to 1943, inclusive. \$3000.00 in each of the years 1944 to 1948 inclusive;

(c) Interest-bearing time warrants designated "Sabine County Warrants", dated the 10th day of October, 1929, bearing 6% interest, numbered 2, 3 and 4 numbers 2 and 3 being of the denomination of \$1000 each, and number 4 being in the denomination of \$651.00, aggregating 2,651.00, maturing \$1000 in 1931, \$1000 in 1932 and \$651.00 in 1933.

(d) Bonds designated "Sabine County Bridge Repair Bonds, Series "A", dated the 14th day of December 1925, bearing 6% interest numbered 1 to 4 inclusive, number 1 being of the denomination of \$495.00 and numbers 2, 3 and 4 of the denomination of \$500.00 each, aggregating 1,995.00, maturing April 10, 1936.

(e) Bonds designated "Sabine County Bridge Repair bonds, series "B", dated the 15th day of December, 1925, bearing 6% interest, numbered 1 to 4 inclusive, of the denomination of \$500.00 each except No. 1 for \$495.00, aggregating \$1,995.00, and maturing April 10, 1937.

(f) Bonds designated "Sabine County Road Repair Bonds, Series "C" dated the 16th day of December, 1925, bearing 6% interest, numbered 1 to 4 inclusive, of the denomination of

\$500.00 each except No. 1 for \$995.00 aggregating 1,995.00, maturing April 10, 1933.

TOTAL of outstanding warrants bonds, ----- \$40,656.00.

Whereas, all of said interest-bearing time warrants and the original scrip warrants on which they were based were issued in all particulars in accordance with law, including R. S. Art. 2368, and the various provisions of the law applicable thereto; and

Whereas, all of said bonds were issued in accordance with the provisions of law applicable thereto; and

(a) CONCERNING SCRIPT WARRANTS:

Whereas, certain scrip warrants were outstanding as legal indebtedness against said Road & Bridge fund of said County on May 31, 1931, and are now outstanding legal indebtedness against said fund; and

Whereas, in each instance where the item of scrip is in excess of \$2,000.00 the contract furnishing the basis of said expenditure was first submitted to competitive bids after prior notice by publication as required by law, and was awarded upon competitive bids at a regular term of Court, except where any one of said items of scrip represents the aggregate amount of separate and independent contracts of purchase of material and the performance of labor, such warrants being issued to cover the aggregate total, and in each instance where the item of scrip is in excess of \$500.00 and less than \$2,000.00 the contract furnishing the basis of said expenditures was first submitted to competitive bids and said contract was awarded upon competitive bids at a regular term of court, except in those instances where said scrip represented expenditure for work done under the immediate supervision of the Commissioners' court and paid for by the day, and in those instances where the terms of scrip are for more than \$500.00 and where there were no competitive bids as described above, said warrants represent the indebtedness for several distinct transactions or contracts, the amount of no item or contract being in excess of \$500.00, thus issued in compliance with Article 2368, et seq., Revised Statutes of 1925, as in effect prior to May 21, 1931, and

Whereas, the Court has determined that the scrip thus issued and outstanding does not exceed in any one of the years the contemplated revenue for either or any of said years; and

Whereas, said scrip outstanding against the Road and Bridge fund of the County as described as follows:

Whereas, on May 21, 1931, the date House Bill Number 312, passed by the regular session of the Forty-second Legislature, became effective, there was outstanding certain legal indebtedness of said County chargeable against its Permanent Improvement Fund, represented by interest-bearing time warrants and scrip warrants theretofore issued by said County; and

Whereas, said warrants which existed, and were outstanding at the time said act became effective, still constitute legal, outstanding and unpaid obligations of said Sabine County; and

Whereas, the total of said outstanding warrants above described is \$15,216.19; and

Whereas, it is considered to be to the best interest of said Court to fund said warrants into funding bonds of the County, in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas; and

Whereas, after levying the tax to pay the principal and interest of said funding bonds, and after making provisions for all other fixed charges against the county, chargeable to said fund;

Be it ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners' court of Sabine County, Texas:

Section 1. That the bonds of the County to be called "Sabine County Permanent Improvement Funding Bonds, Series of 1931", be issued under and by virtue of House Bill Number 312, passed by the regular session of the Forty-second Legislature, effective May 21, 1931, and by virtue of the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, in the amount of \$15,216.19, for the purpose of funding, cancelling and in lieu of the evidence of certain outstanding indebtedness of Sabine County, Texas, chargeable against the Permanent Improvement Fund, existing on May 21, 1931, consisting of interest-bearing time warrants and script warrants.

Section 2. That said bonds shall be numbered consecutively from 1 to 16, inclusive, shall be of the denomination of \$1000.00 each, except No. 1 for \$216.19, and shall become due and payable as follows:

The County of Sabine, State of Texas, duly organized under the laws of the State of Texas, for value received, hereby promises to pay to the bearer hereof, on the 10th day of April, 19-- the sum of One Thousand Dollars, in lawful money of the United States of America, with interest thereon from date hereof, at the rate of 6% perannum; interest payable April 10, 1932, and semi-annually thereafter on the 10th day of October and 10th day of April each year, principal and interest payable upon presentation and surrender of bond or proper coupon at the Central Hanover Bank and Trust Co., New York, City, N.Y. and the County of Sabine, is hereby held and firmly bound, and its faith and credit and all real and personal property in said County are hereby pledged for the prompt payment of the principal of this bond and the interest thereon, at maturity;

This bond is one of a series of sixteen bonds, numbered from 1 to 16 inclusive, of the denomination of \$1000.00 each, except Bond Number 1 for \$216.19, issued for the purpose of funding, cancelling and in lieu of the evidences of certain indebtedness of the County of Sabine, in like amount, existing May 21, 1931, against the Permanent Improvement fund of said County, incurred for the construction and repairs and improvement of the courthouse and Jail and other permanent improvements, consisting of legally issued, subsisting warrants of said County, all of which original warrants have been duly cancelled by the proper authorities before the issuance of this bond and of the series of which it is a part.

This issue of bonds was expressly authorized by an order passed by the Commissioners' court of Sabine County, Texas, duly recorded in the minutes of said Commissioners' court.

The date of this bond in conformity with the order above mentioned, is the 15th day of July 1931.

Section 11. The Comptroller shall not register said bonds except as and when there shall be surrendered to him said warrants aggregating in amounts the respective amounts of the bonds then to be registered. The holder or holders of said original indebtedness shall be entitled to the accrued interest of the funding bonds, as compensation for not drawing interest on the original warrants beyond the date calculated in this ordinance.

Section 12. The comptroller is authorized to accept from J. R. Phillips Investment Company of Houston, Texas, or upon its order, the original items of indebtedness, and is authorized to deliver to the said J. R. Phillips Investment Company, or upon its order said funding bonds as and when issued, in accordance with written instructions to be given by the County Judge.

Section 13. That to pay the interest on said bonds and to create a sinking fund sufficient to discharge them as they mature, a tax of four one-half cents on the One Hundred dollars' assessed valuation of all taxable property in the County of Sabine, is hereby levied for the year 1931, out of the constitutional Twenty-five (25%) cents Permanent Improvement Fund of said County and said tax shall be assessed and collected, and there shall be calculated each year, while any of said bonds are outstanding and unpaid, whatever rate of tax is necessary to provide current interest and the required amount of the principal for such year, or a proportionate part thereof, and a tax at such rate on the one hundred dollars' valuation of property, and with the rates permitted by the Constitution, shall be levied, assessed and collected during each of said years, and said tax is hereby levied, ordered to be levied, assessed and collected, and the taxes levied and collected shall, be applied to said purpose and to no other purpose.

Section 14. All taxes in process of collection for the benefit of the issues of interest-bearing time warrants funded in this bond issue and all moneys in the sinking funds of said respective warrant issued are hereby appropriated to the interest and sinking fund of this bond issue. The County Judge, County Clerk, and County Treasurer are directed to take such steps as are necessary to transfer said funds to the interest and sinking fund for this bond issue. Provided, however, that said transfer shall be made proportionately from time to time, as and when said interest-bearing time warrants have been actually surrendered in exchange for said funding bonds, in such manner that outstanding warrants not exchanged will always be protected by a proper interest and sinking fund heretofore provided for that purpose.

Section 15. It is further ordered, that the County Judge shall be and he is hereby auth-

orized to take and have charge of all necessary records pending investigation and approval by the attorney General and shall have control of said bonds, during said time. After the record has been approved the County Judge is authorized to leave the bonds in the office of the Comptroller, pending the exchange for the original warrants and pending their registration, which may be at one time or in instalments.

Section 16. It is further adjudged and decreed that all things required to be done by law in the issuance of said original warrants funded herein have happened and been performed in due time, form and manner as required by law; that the county received full and lawful value for all of said warrants funding hereby; that all acts heretofore performed by the Commissioners' court and by the several county officials in reference thereto, are hereby expressly ratified, and said original warrants are hereby ratified; that all acts required by law and all things required by law to have happened, in reference to this issue of Funding bonds have happened and been performed in due time, form, and manner as required by law; that this finding is made for the benefit of the prospective holders of said bonds and for the benefit of the Attorney General of Texas.
