Therefore, the Commissioners court of abine County, Texas, does hereby find and affirmatively adjudge that the financial condition of eabine County will not permit such boms to be made to mature in such installments as well make the burden of taxation to support same approximately uniform throughout the term of said bond issue, unless the maturities as listed in the hereinherore mentioned bond order make the burden of taxation to pay same approximately uniform.
