

The Commissioners' court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in regular session, September 28th, 1931, with the following members present, to-wit: R.H. Dent County Judge, E. J. McGown Commissioner Prec. No. 1, N. E. Mc Daniel, Commissioner Prec. No. 2, W. R. Low, Commissioner Prec. No. 3, J. E. Minton, Commissioner Prec. No. 4. Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, and E. B. Smith, sheriff, and among other things, the following business was transacted, to-wit:

It is ordered by the court, that Sinking funds of Road Districts be invested in Permanent Improvement Funding Warrants as follows:

Road Districts No. 1, in warrants 1 to 6 inc. of \$500.00, each,	\$3,000.00.
" " " 3, " " 7 & 8 " " \$500.00, "	1,000.00.
" " " 6, " " 9 " " \$500.00, "	500.00.
" " " 12, " " 10 & 11 " " \$500.00, "	1,000.00.

this being a total of \$5,500.00 of this issued. See book M. page 609.

Investments in the second issued, aggregating \$9,716.19, invested as follows, See Book N. page 89.

Road District No. 5, in Warrants 1 & 2 inc. for \$716.19, and \$1,000.00 respectively, a total of \$1716.19.

Road District No. 4, in warrants 3 to 5 inc. of \$1,000.00 each, \$3,000.00.

The total of the two issues being \$100216.19.

The balance of the total of these issued aggregating \$15,216.19, or \$5,000.00 is deferred investment until a later date, or as such times as the amount of sinking funds on hand will justify their purchase.

The American Surety Company having served notice on the Commissioners' court, near the 1st of August, that B. A. Minton, Constable of Precinct No. 8, Sabine County, Texas, had failed to pay the premium on his bond requested that they, the said Surety Company, be released from any obligations as surety. Constable Minton was requested by letter of Date August 22nd, to file new bond, which he having failed to do, the American Surety is now released and the officer of Constable of Precinct No. 8, of said Sabine County, is declared vacant.

No commissioners' bills were filed at this meeting.

It is ordered by the court that official salaries be allowed for August and September out of the P. I. Fund, in the amount of \$2502.50, for the months August and September this being in form and for the purpose of a loan from the P. I. Fund to the General County Fund, G. W. Russell, \$150.00, Mrs. Berta Harper, \$150.00, R.H. Dent, \$250.00, E. B. Smith, \$166.00, P. S. Goen \$175.00, A. G. Pratt, \$150.00, E. J. McGown, \$75.00, N. E. McDaniel, \$150.00, W. R. Low, \$150.00, J. E. Minton, \$ ---, W. R. Hyden, \$100.00.

It is ordered by the court that the allowance to the Sheriff for feeding prisoners be reduced from 75¢ per day to 60¢ per day per prisoner.
