

The Commissioners' court of Sabine County, Texas, met in Regular Session December 14th, 1931, with the following members present, to-wit: R.H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McGown, Commr. Prect. No. 1, W. R. Low, Commr. Prect. No. 2, N. E. McDaniel, Commr. Prect. No. 3, J. E. Minton, Commr. Prect. No. 4, Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, and E. B. Smith, sheriff, and transacted business as follows:

A petition to be annexed to hog law territory was presented to the court, said petition being by C. W. Fuller, and three others, petition granted.

A petition asking for a change of road leading from the M. S. Morris place to Sabinetown was presented to the court, but was not granted. Notice of said petition setting forth the purpose and names of petitioners will be posted prior to final hearing, December 28th, 1931.

On certificate of Dr. W. L. Arnold, as to disability of Adron Toy Carlton, to perform manual labor, and his request to be exempt from road duty, it is ordered by the court that he be exempt from further road duty.

No further business at this time, court is adjourned.

PETITION TO JOIN STOCK LAW TERRITORY

Hemphill, Texas, Nov. 10th, 1931.

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS.

We, the undersigned persons, owners of the hereinafter described lands, which adjoin lands in which a stock law prevails, and in which hogs, sheep and goats are not permitted to run at large, hereby petition your honorable body to include the following lands and territory in said stock law territory and that you pass an order extending the stock law forbidding the running at large of hogs, sheep and goats in such territory, said territory being fully described as follows:

Beginning at a stake for corner; the southeast corner of J. E. King's 4-1/5 acres of land on the Joseph Walker league; Thence north with the east line of said King's land to the south margin of the right-of-way of A. B. & G. Ry; thence with the South margin of said railway right-of-way, in a northwesterly direction to the Hemphill-Milam highway No. 87; Thence in a southwesterly direction with the South margin of said highway No. 87, to the N. W. corner of C. W. Fuller's home tract of land, stake on the South side of said highway and in the east side of the W. F. Goodrich, addition to the town of Hemphill; Thence south with C. W. Fuller's east line to stake for corner, his S. W. corner on the N. B. line of S. Emanuel, et al, 160 acres. Thence N. 88 E. with the South boundary line of C. W. Fuller's lands and the north line of the Emanuel tract continuing same course with the S. B. line of W. T. Arnold's lands and J. E. King's lands to the place of beginning.

and passed the following order;

It appearing that on the 14th day of July, 1931, this court passed an order authorizing the issuance of \$72,800.00, Sabine County Road & Bridge Funding Bonds, Series of 1931, bearing interest at the rate of 6% per annum, and maturing serially;

And it further appearing to the court that Section 13 of said bond order should be amended as hereinafter more fully set out;

It is therefore ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the commissioners' court of Sabine County, Texas, that Section 13 of the hereinbefore mentioned bond order, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

SECTION 13.

That to pay the interest on said bonds and to create a sinking fund sufficient to discharge them as they mature, a tax of fifteen (15c) cents on the one hundred dollars, assessed valuation, of all taxable property in the County of Sabine, is hereby levied for the year 1931 and for each succeeding year while said bonds or any of them are outstanding, out of the constabulary

ional fifteen (15) cents Road and Bridge fund of said County, and said tax shall be assessed, and collected, and three shall be calculated each year, while any of said bonds are outstanding and unpaid, whatever rate of tax is necessary to provide current interest and the required amount of the principal for such year, or a proportionate part thereof, and a tax at such rate on the one hundred dollars' valuation of taxable property, and within the rates permitted by the constitution, shall be levied, assessed and collected during each of said years, and said tax is hereby levied, ordered to be levied, assessed and collected, and the taxes levied and collected shall be applied to said purpose and to no other purpose.
