

The Commissioners' court of Sabine County, Texas, met in regular session January 11th, 1932, with all members present, to-wit: R.H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McEown, Commr. Prect. No. 1, W. R. Loy, Commr. Prect. No. 2, N. E. McDaniel, Commr. Prect. No. 3, E. J. McEown, Commr. Prect. No. 4, and among others the following business was had to-wit:

It is ordered by the court that script No. 135, register No. 3145, issued to Tom ~~Lee~~, in the amount of \$8.00 of date 12-14-31, be cancelled and that two warrants in lieu thereof, be issued against the same fund, one in the amount of \$2.66 the other in the amount of \$5.94, said cancellation being for the purpose of permitting the payment of County Advalorem taxes. Also that warrants No.s 1510 & 236, Register Nos. 2855 & 3208 Res. in the amounts of \$12.00 & \$9.00 respectively, issued to W. A. Forsworthy, of date 2-23-31 & 1-6-32, be cancelled and two warrants in lieu thereof, one for \$16.66 and other for \$4.34 both the above warrants be

issued against the same fund and to the same persons to whom they were originally issued.

There being no further business at this time, court adjourned.
