Two orders were passed by the court as follows:

First, that W. B. Tucker and J. B. Fox be permitted to pay tax on their fractional mineral rights at the same value as the last two years. The full 50% being an error in assessment. The tax collector is authorized to accept a payment accordingly.

Second. That ten thousand Seven Hundred Dollars of the Permanent School Fund be invested in bonds as follows:

100	\$100 denomination bearing 5% interest by Hemphill School District original issue	\$800.
15	\$500 denomination, Hemphill Independent Refunding 5%	7,500.
3	\$800 denomination, Ruddell Common School District bearing 5% interest.	2,400.

The price to be paid being par and accrued interest. The County Depository is directed to

make all necessary charges and entries in accordance with such transaction.

Script is ordered issued for Commissioners' precincts for road expenses incurred to date.
