

CLERK OF THE COUNTY COURT  
June 10, 1932

The Commissioners' court met in Special Session on the 10th day of June, 1932, with the following members present, to-wit: R.H. Dent, County Judge, E.J. McGown, Commr. Prec. No. 1, Daniel, Commr. Prec. No. 2, J. E. Minton, Commr. Prec. No. 4, and Mrs. Bertha [unclear] Clerk, and passed two orders, as follows, to-wit:

1. That \$4,779.98, in script warrants, which was taken up by the County Treasurer, and which was included in funding issues, be paid to J.R. Phillips Investment Company, on conditions that they take up that amount of script and that is held by the county, and surrender it in exchange for funding warrants, and also take up \$15,718.15, script held by the First National Bank of Memphis, and \$501.89, additional script that is included in the funding order, making a total of \$19,000.00 script to be taken up by said J.R. Phillips Investment Company, and surrendered for an equal amount of Funding Warrants.

2. That \$19,000.00 of Road District Sinking Funds be invested in County Security, viz: General Fund, Funding Warrant, of the same amount for the purpose of retiring script issued to date, 1st, 1931.

No further business coming on at this time, court is adjourned.
