

MINUTES OF BOARD OF EQUALIZATION
June 27, to 29, Inc.

On this the 27th day of June, 1932, the Commissioners' Court with all members present re-convened as a Board of Equalization to hear reasons by any whose property has been raised, and to allow them the opportunity to show cause, if any they can, why such raises should not be made final.

By motion and second duly read and carried it is ordered by the Court that a ten (10%) per cent reduction be made on all real estate and town lots such reduction to be made from the valuation of 1931 or from the value on which notice was given for 1932.

And on this the 29th day of June, 1932, the Commissioners' Court sitting as a board of equalization, after having heard all parties, desiring to show cause why their property should not stand as raised by such board, and after having agreed to adjustments, are made values final on all properties on which hearings were had the said Board of Equalization is declared

adjourned.
