

The Commissioners' court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in regular session, September 12th, 1932, with the following members presents, to-wit: R.H. Dent, County Judge, E. J. McGown, Commr. Precinct No. 1, N. E. McDaniel, Commissioner Precinct No. 2, J. M. Minton, Commissioner, Precinct No. 4, and Mrs. Berta Harper, County Clerk, and transacted the following business:

The following orders were passed, to-wit:

It is ordered by the court that the County Treasurer, D. S. Sibley, place to the credit of the Endleton Ferry Funds, Gas Tax Voucher, for \$42.00, for the reason that said fund is exhausted, and that the contract of Ferryman, for 1932, was made on a cash basis, and which amount is intended, will relieve said fund, till other funds are available, or until relief of some kind may be had.

It is ordered by the court that H.L. Jordan, be furnished an iron culvert at the point where the road from his house joins highway No. 93, and that same be installed and kept in repair by the Commissioners' court and their successors in office, this being in consideration of Mr. Jordan having furnished free, 20 feet of right-of-way in 1928, while others were being paid also, on condition that he now furnished deed to 50 feet of right-of-way which included that already conveyed beginning, at road center as now surveyed and extending through his lands to the width of 50 feet.

It is ordered by the court that Earl Puckley be allowed to use an old Fordson Crawler type Tractor #0 Saw Lumber conditioned that he will furnish Sabine County, with at least \$125.00 worth of lumber of such quality and price as meets the approval of the Commissioners' court, and until such lumber is furnished the title to said Tractor vest in Sabine County through its agents, the Commissioners' court and they retain the right to sell the same to another buyer at any time they deem proper or see that the lumber in payment of same is not being furnished in a satisfactory time, or manner. In case said lumber is furnished satisfactorily, between now and December 15th, 1932, title to said Tractor will vest in the said Earl Puckley.

There being no further business, court is adjourned.
