
The Commissioners' court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Special session December 26th, 1932, with all members present to wit: R.H. Dent County Judge, E.J. McGown, Commr. Precinct No. 1, N.E. McDaniel, Commr. Precinct no. 2, W. R. Low, Commr. Precinct No. 3 and J.E. Minton, Commr. Precinct No. 4, Mrs. Berta Harpr, County Clerk, and transacted business as follows:

On this day was presented and approved bonds of elected officers for years 1933, -1934, to wit: Miss Zeda Fay Davidson, County Clerk, Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, Ross Kenner, Tax Collector, D. A. Sibley, Deputy Tax Collector, Edward Harper, Co. Judge, H.E. White, Commr. Precinct No. 1, Eugene Davidson, Justice of the Peace Precinct No. 1, and J.H. Folker Constable Precinct No. 1. There being no further business, court adjourned until Dec. 31, 1932.

The Tax Collector is authorized to accept scrip in payment of legal publications as a credit on Ad Valorem taxes, as this is not construed by us to mean merchandise, but is such a service that required cash payment and for which the publisher is entitled to cash remuneration.

It is therefore ordered by the court that Eli Main be allowed to pay County Ad Valorem taxes with scrip held by him in payment of legal publications.

It is also ordered by the court that scrip issued for the cleansing of jail bedding and laundry work be assessed as a service for which the holder may be entitled to demand cash, such service not classed as merchandise and the holder thereof, be entitled likewise to credit on ad Valorem taxes for such scrip.

It is ordered by the court that General County Funding Warrants Nos. 106, to 112, inclusive, of \$1000.00 each, owned by the County Permanent School Fund be exchanged for General County Funding Warrants nos. 26-39, inclusive of \$500.00 each, owned by Road District Sinking Fund.

The purpose of the exchange being to shorten maturities in Road District Sinking Fund and to supply longer maturities in the Permanent School Fund.

There being no further business court adjourned.
