On motion by H.4. White, second by R. W. hapman motion carrying unenimously, it is ordered by the court that the official bonds of Compods, as ustice of the Peace Precince # 3, and of H. L. Williams, as Constable Precinct #3, be and the same are hereby in all things approved.

It is ordered, after motion by Ernest Smith, second by P.H.Mcgown, and carrying unanimous that the sheriff be althowed \$20.00 per month for Court house janitor.

On Motion by H. ... hite, second by R. ... hapman, carrying unanimously, it is ordered by the court that the sheriff, be allowed 50% per day for feeding prisoners and that his deputy J.M. Hyden, be allowed \$75.00 per month.

On motion by P.H.McGown, second by R. P. hapman, it is ordered by the court that all County officers, make their quarterly reports to the Commissioners court, regularly, February regular term, Commissioners' court, 1933.

... No further business, court is adjourned.
