
The Commissioners' court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Special Session January 3, 1933, with the following members present, to-wit, Edward Harper, County Judge, H.E. White, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, P.H. McGown, Commr. Prec. No. 3, Ernest Smith, Commr. Prec. no. 2, R.W. Chapman, Commr. Prec. No. 4, Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, and Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, and after court being duly open by proclamation of the sheriff, business was transacted as follows:

On motion by H.E. White, second by R.W. Chapman, motion carrying unanimously, it is ordered by the court that the official bonds of G.C. Woods, as Justice of the Peace Precinct # 3, and of H. L. Williams, as Constable Precinct #3, be and the same are hereby in all things approved.

It is ordered, after motion by Ernest Smith, second by P.H. McGown, and carrying unanimously, that the sheriff be allowed \$20.00 per month for Court house janitor.

On Motion by H.E. White, second by R.W. Chapman, carrying unanimously, it is ordered by the court that the sheriff, be allowed 50¢ per day for feeding prisoners and that his deputy J.M. Hyden, be allowed \$75.00 per month.

On motion by P.H. McGown, second by R.W. Chapman, it is ordered by the court that all County officers, make their quarterly reports to the Commissioners court, regularly, beginning, with February regular term, Commissioners' court, 1933.

No further business, court is adjourned.
