

The Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas met in Regular Session January 9th, 1933, with the following members present, to-wit: Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, Edward Harper, Co. Judge, H. E. White, Commr. Prec. No. 1, Ernest Smith, Commr. Prec. No. 4, P. H. McGown, Commr. Prec. No. 2, R. W. Chapman, Commr. Prec. No. 4, and Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, and after court was fully opened by the sheriff, the following business was transacted to-wit:

On motion by P. H. McGown, second by H. E. White, vote unanimous, It is ordered by the court that the bond of Fred Oliphint as County Surveyor of Sabine County, be, and the same is hereby in all things approved.

It is ordered by the court that C. L. Ford Service Station, Bronson, Texas, be designated and the same is hereby designated as an authorized headlight Testing Station for Sabine County, as is made and provided by law. On motion by Ernest Smith, second by P. H. McGown, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court, that the bond of C. L. Ford, for the faithful performance of the duties of a headlight Testing Station, be, and the same is hereby in all things approved.

On application duly presented to the court, and by motion of Ernest Smith, second by P. H. McGown, it is ordered by the court that Dr. W. T. Arnold, be, and he is hereby appointed County Health officer, of Sabine County, Texas.

On motion by P. H. McGown, second by R. W. Chapman, it is ordered by the court, that D. A. Sibley, be, and he is hereby appointed Deputy Tax Collector of Sabine County, Texas.

A motion by made by Ernest Smith, and second by P. H. McGown, that P. S. Goen, County Demonstration agent of Sabine County, be discharged from further duties. Ernest Smith, P. H. McGown, and R. W. Chapman, voted "aye" and H. E. White voting "No", making a majority voting for the discharge of the further services of P. S. Goen. It is therefore ordered by the court that P. S. Goen be, and he is hereby discharged from further services as County Demonstration agent, and that he be paid the sum of \$27.80 out of the Gen. County fund, for services from Jan. 1st, 1932 to Jan. 10th, 1932. Inc.

On motion by P. H. McGown, second by H. E. White, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that Stationery and office supplies for the County be purchased by the County Judge, Edward Harper.

On motion by R. W. Chapman, 2nd by P. H. McGown, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that the Service Station on Main Street in Bronson, Texas, operated by R. Ludlow and H. T. Russell, be, and the same is hereby designated as a headlight Testing Station, as is made and provided by law, and their bond for same is hereby in all things approved.
