
The Commissioners' court in and for Sabine County, met in special session January 25th 1933, with the following members present to-wit: Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, Edward Harper, County Judge, H.E. White; Commissioner Prec. No. 1. P.H. McGown, Commr. Prec. No. 2, Ernest Smith, Commr. Prec. No. 3, R. W. Chapman, Commissioner Prec. No. 4, and Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, and transacted business as follows, after court was duly opened by the Sheriff.

On motion made by H.E. White, second by R.W. Chapman, with H.E. White, and P.H. McGown, and Edward Harper, voting Aye, and R.W. Chapman, and Ernest Smith, voting No, it is ordered by the court that the act of the Commissioners' court discharging P.P. Yoen, from further services as County Demonstration Agent, be rescinded and that his services be extended, and they are hereby extended until July 1st, 1933, at the rate of \$.50.00 per month.

On motion by H.E. White, second by R.W. Chapman, vote unanimous, it ordered by the court as follows:

That Script No. 513, in the sum of \$11.75, issued to Otha Hamilton, be void and the same is

hereby cancelled, and script in lieu thereof, be issued in the amount of \$9.00 and \$2.75, for the same purpose and on the same fund.

That Scrip No. 276, in the sum of \$2.50, issued to Carroll Dickey, be and the same is hereby cancelled and script in lieu thereof be issued in the amount of \$1.20 and \$1.30, out of the same fund and for the same purpose.

That Scrip No. 328, in the amount of \$3.60, issued to R. Sibley, be and the same is hereby cancelled and script in lieu thereof be issued in the amount of \$1.35 and \$2.25, out of the same fund and for the same purpose.

That Scrip No. 522, issued to G.S. Low, in the amount of \$22.00 be and the same is hereby cancelled, and script in lieu thereof be issued in the amount of \$12.45 and \$9.55, for the same purpose and out of the same fund.

The above orders having been made for the purpose of making it possible for the payment of taxes with script.

That the County Commissioners be allowed \$83.35 per month, providing they have ben on duty the amount of days to equal said amount, and 75% per cent of which amount is to be paid out of the Road and Bridge Fund, and 25% out of the Gemral County Fund.
