

The Commissioners' court of Sabine County met in Special Session, January 31st, 1933, with the following members present, to-wit: Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, Edward Harper, County Judge H. E. White, Commr. Prec. No. 1, P. H. McGown, Commr. Prec. No. 2, Ernest Smith, Commr. Prec. No. 3, R. W. Chapman, Commr. Prec. No. 4, Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, and after court was opened by the sheriff, the following business, was transacted, to-wit:

Whereas, it has been made known to the Commissioners court by W. H. Mason, that the Assessor of Sabine County, has assessed, 60 acres of the James Mason League belonging to W. H. Mason, as being within the limits of Road District No. 3, when as a matter of fact said 60 acres are outside of said District No. 3, and he has requested the court to correct said error. And on Motion by R. W. Chapman, second by P. H. McGown, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that the Tax Collector, Ross Kenner be instructed to collect the Road District Taxes due by the said W. H. Mason on only 327 acres of said Mason League and to charge the remainder of the road tax off as an error in assessment.

On motion by Ernest Smith, seconded by H. E. White, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court as follows:

That Tax Collector, Ross Kenner, be, and he is hereby authorized to refund to B. Miller, the difference in taxes of Road District # 4 and # 5, for the year 1932, and charge the amount to error in Assessment, for the reason that Mr. B. Miller lives in Road District # 4, and assessed for Road District No. 5.

That the Tax Collector, Ross Kenner, be and he is hereby authorized to refund to D. B. Masley the difference in taxes of Road District No. 4 and No. 5, for the years 1930 and 1931, and charge the amount to error in assessment, Mr. Masley also living in District # 4 and assessed for District No. 5.

That Tax Collector, Ross Kenner, be and he is hereby authorized to deduct from the taxes of D. B. Masley, for the year 1932, the difference between Road District # 4, taxes and Road District No. 5, taxes, for the reason that Mr. Masley is assessed for the year 1932 for taxes in District No. 5, and lives in District No. 4, the amount to be deducted to be charged to error in assessment.

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that the bonds of D. L. Cooper as Constable of Precinct No. 2, and L. L. McDonald as Justice of the Peace Precinct No. 2, be, and the same are hereby, in all things, approved.

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court as follows:
That scrip Nos. 194, 154, 35, and 104, in the amounts of \$3.00, \$3.00, \$3.00, \$6.00, respectively, issued to A.L. McVown, for service on County School Board be cancelled, and scrip in lieu thereof, be issued out of the Gen. Co. Fund, in the amount of \$15.00, for the same purpose.

That scrip No. 787, in the amount of \$106.67, issued to C.M. Bennett, be cancelled and scrip in lieu thereof, be issued out of the same fund, for the same purpose but in the following amounts: One piece for \$4.20, one for \$12.47, and nine pieces of \$10.00 each.

That scrip No. 537, issued to Ben Hamilton, out of the R. & B. Fund, for \$12.00, be cancelled and scrip in lieu thereof, be issued in the amounts of \$7.35 and \$4.65, out of the same fund and for the same purpose.

That scrip No. 536, issued to W. B. Palmer, out of the R. & B. Fund, in the amount of \$15.00, be cancelled and scrip in lieu thereof, in the amounts of \$6.45, and \$8.55, out of the same fund and for the same purpose.

That scrip No. 658, issued to W. W. Noel, in the amount of \$34.00, out of the R. & B. fund, be cancelled, and scrip in lieu thereof, in the amounts of \$20.55 and \$13.45, out of the same fund and for the same purpose.

That scrip No. 1049, in the amount of \$5.00, issued to A. A. Durrell, out of the Gen. Co. fund, be cancelled and scrip in lieu thereof, in the amount of \$1.65 and \$3.35, be issued out of the same fund and for the same purpose.

On motion duly had and carried it is ordered by the court that the Monthly reports of L.E. King, and Edward Harper, be, and the same are hereby in all things approved.

No further business, court is adjourned.
