

The Honorable Commissioners' court, met in Regular Session, February 13th, 1933, with all members present, to-wit: Edward Harper, County Judge, H.E. White, Commr. Prec. No. 1, Ernest Smith, Commr. Prec. No. 2, P.H. McGown, Commr. Prec. No. 3, R.W. Chapman, Commr. Prec. No. 4, Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, and Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, and after court was opened by the sheriff, the following business has transacted, to-wit:

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that the Resignation of Eugene Davidson as Justice of the Peace Precinct No. 1, be, and it is hereby accepted, and he, the said Eugene Davidson, is hereby discharged from further duties of said office.

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that the application of W.H. Pratt, as Justice of the Peace Precinct No. 1, be accepted, and he is hereby appointed to fill the vacancy made by the resignation of Eugene Davidson, and that the bond of W.H. Pratt, for Justice of the Peace be and the same is hereby approved.

On motion by P.H. McGown, second by Ernest Smith, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that the appointment of O.A. Davidson, by Herbert Folk, as Deputy Constable, of Precinct No. 1, be and the same is hereby in all things confirmed.

On motion by ^{R.W.}Chapman, second by ^{Ernest}Smith, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that script in the amount of \$6.00, #125, issued to Grady Stewart, be cancelled, and script in lieu thereof be issued in the amounts of \$4.50 and \$1.50, on the same fund and for the same purpose.

On motion by P.H. McGown, second by H.E. White, it is ordered by the court that script in the amount of \$156.99, issued to Germalien Chemical Company, out of the P.I. Fund, for Chemicals & disinfectants, be and the same is hereby cancelled and script in lieu thereof be issued out of the Gen. County Fund and for the same purpose.

On motion by Ernest Smith, second by R.W. Chapman, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that the bond of W.H. Waller, as ferryman, at Bendleton, be and the same is hereby in all things approved.

On motion by P.H. McGown, second by R.W. Chapman, vote unanimous, it is ordered that the monthly reports of Edward Harper, Zeda Davidson, and J.P. McGown, be and they are hereby in all respects approved.

On motion by P.H. McGown, second by R.W. Chapman, ^{vote unanimous,} it is ordered by the court that Ross Kenner, Tax Collector, be, and he is hereby authorized to deduct from his January report, of taxes of Mack Jones property, amounts as follows: County Advalorem: \$4.50. School Dist. 31. \$1.88, Road Dist. No. 10. \$1.88, same being an error in making annual settlement.

On motion by H.E. White, second by R.W. Chapman, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that Scrip # 656, issued to Sabine County Telephone Company, for \$39.60, be cancelled, and scrip in lieu thereof be issued to R.M. Pinkston, for services, out of the same fund.

On motion by H.E. White, second by P.H. McGown, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that the County Clerk be allowed the sum of \$100.00 per year, payable monthly, for posting the Finance ledger.

After consideration of application, it is motioned and seconded, and voted unanimous that Marvin Honeycutt be, and he is hereby authorized to employ Truda Chance, as Deputy District Clerk of Sabine County, Texas.

On motion by R.W. Chapman, seconded by H.E. White, it is ordered by the court, that the following named men be, and they are hereby appointed election officers for the General Election

Whereas, on this the 13th day of February, A.D. 1933, was the time for the selection of a County Depository for the ensuing two years, and

Whereas, no bid for such depository has been received by the court, and

Whereas, it is necessary that a County Depository be selected for the ensuing two years, and

Whereas, the First National Bank in Hemphill is the only bank in the County, and is the present depository and is willing to continue to act for the ensuing two years as the County Depository and pay to the County two (2) per cent interest on daily balances.

On motion by P.H.McGown, second by H.E.White, vote unanimous,

It is therefore ordered that the First National Bank in Hemphill be and is hereby selected and designated as the County Depository for Sabine County for the ensuing two (2) years, upon the filing of the statutory bonds.

It is further ordered that the County Treasurer be and is hereby instructed during said two years to retain as much as \$20,000.00 at all times on deposit in said depository.

It is further ordered that Sabine County shall pay seven (7) per cent interest on warrants carried by the Bank during said period.

In the selection of said depository, it is further agreed that at the end of the period of two years, or at any time before such period, should said bank cease to be the County Depository, and any other depository selected, that the County will thereupon pay off in full the County Scrip carried by the bank.

It is contemplated that said depository shall not be required during any current year to carry more of the County scrip against any fund than is covered by current expenses of said year and that will be paid by the taxes levied for said year.

There being no further business, court is adjourned.
