
On this the 16th day of May, 1933, The board of Equalization, after having been in session 8 days, is adjourned as A Board of Equalization, until June 13, at which time a hearing will be had by the court, of the parties who desire to show cause, if any there be, why raises on their values should be imposed on property rendered by them, for tax purposes for the year 1933.

The Court is immediately, on the same day, convened in Special Session, at which time the following business was transacted.

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that Scrip No. 695 and 58, issued to A.L. McGown, and No. 773 and 89, issued to E.E. Solly, for services on County Board be cancelled, and scrip in lieu thereof, be issued for the same purpose, in the same amount and out of the Current Expense, Gen Co. Fund, and that other scrip for the same service to the

members of the County Board, be issued out of said fund.

There being no further Business, court is adjourned.
