

The Commissioner's court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Regular session June 12th 1933 with all members present, to wit: Edward Harper, County Judge, H.E. White, Commr. Prect. No. 1, E.C. Smith, Commr. Prect. No. 2, P.H. McGown, Commr. Prect. No. 3, R.W. Chapman, Commr. Prect. No. 4, Zeda Davidson, Clerk, and Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, and transacted the following business:

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that Scrip #s 742, 743 & 914, issued to Geo. D. Byrne, in the amounts of \$5.00, \$9.00 and \$8.00 respectively, be cancelled and scrip in lieu thereof, be issued in the like amounts and for the same purpose (same being Justice Ct. fees and recording Birth and Death Certificates), but on the Gen. County Current Expense fund.

On motion by P.H. McGown, Second by R.W. Chapman, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that Report of B.N. Edgar, as butcherer, be approved.

On motion by P.H. McGown, Second by R.W. Chapman, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that The First National Bank in San Augustine, Texas, be, and the same is hereby designated County Depository of Sabine County, Texas.

On motion duly had and seconded it is ordered by the court that Scrip Nos. 190, 51, and 936, unlawfully issued out of the P.I. Fund be cancelled, and scrip in lieu thereof, be written out of the Gen. Co. fund for the same purpose and for the respective holders.

On motion by P.H. McGown, second by R.W. Chapman, it is ordered by the court that the resignation of R.E. Harrison, as Deputy Constable of Precinct No. 6, be, and the same is hereby accepted, and R.E. Harrison, is hereby discharged from further services.

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that Scrip Nos. 667, 973 & 972, be cancelled, and Script in lieu thereof, be issued out of the Gen. Co. Current Expense Fund, for the same amounts and for the same purpose.

On motion duly had and carried, It is ordered by the court that Monthly reports of Zeda Davidson, W.L. Honeycutt, and L.E. King, be, and the same are hereby in all things approved.

On motion by White, second by P.H. McGown, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that A.G. Pratt, be allowed \$150.00 on assessing taxes, in 1933.

No further business, court adjourned.
