

The Commissioners Court in and for Sabine County, met in regular session June 26th, 1933, with the following members present, to-wit; Edw. Harper, County Judge, H.E. White, Commr. Prec. No. 1, E.C. Smith, Commr. Prec. No. 2, P.H. McEown, Commr. Prec. No. 3, R.W. Chapman, Commr. Prec. No. 4, Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, and Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, and transacted business as follows:

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that Scrip Nos. 126, 35, 127, 365 and 839, issued to R. M. Pinkston, for Telephone Services be cancelled, and scrip in lieu thereof be issued in like amount but out of the P.I. Current Expense fund.

On motion by H. E. White, second by P.H. McEown, it is ordered by the Court that the sum of fifty Dollars per month be appropriated and the same is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the County to be used on Salary for the services of County Agent P.S. Goen, and his services are hereby continued after July 1st, of this year, and shall be continuous from time to time until further notified. We hereby authorize County Judge, Edward Harper, execute papers as recommended by the Extension services of The Agricultural and Mechanical College of Texas.

On motion duly had and carried it is ordered by the court that Scrip # 44, issued to E.C. Smith, on the P.I. Fund, be cancelled and scrip in lieu be issued out of the Gen. Co. Fund.

On motion duly had and carried it is ordered by the court that the monthly report of Zeda Davidson County Clerk, be approved.

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that Scrip No. 804, issued out of the P.I. Fund, be cancelled and scrip in lieu thereof, be issued out of the P.I. Current Expense fund.

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that Scrip # 587, issued on the P.I. Fund, be cancelled and scrip in lieu thereof be issued out of the Gen. Co. Fund.

There being no further business, court is adjourned.
