

ORDER APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR COOPERATIVE EXTENSION WORK IN AGRICULTURE AND HOME ECONOMICS

Under and by the authority of Senate Bill Number 82, passed by the 40th Texas Legislature 1927.

Commissioners' court of Sabine County in session June term, A. D. 1935

It is ordered by the Commissioners' court of Sabine County that the sum of (\$600.00) Six hundred dollars be appropriated and the same is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the County to be used as part salary for a County Agricultural agent, to be assigned to work in this County by the Extension Service of the Agricultural and Mechanical College of Texas.

This appropriation shall become available on July 1st, 1935, or as soon thereafter as the Extension service of the A. & M. College of Texas shall place an agent in said County for duty, and shall be paid out in monthly installments to said Agent upon written order duly signed by an authorized representative of said Extension service.

This appropriation shall be continuous annually until the Commissioners' court or the Extension Service of the A. and M. College of Texas shall decide to discontinue same, and the order of discontinuance shall be passed only during the month of Dec. 1st, which time will be near the close of the season and the year's work. Otherwise this order and agreement shall remain in effect from year to year. The Commissioners' court or the Extension Service of the A. and M. College of Texas shall give notice in writing to the other cooperating agency at least thirty days prior to any official action pertaining to the discontinuance of the work in the county; in the event the work is discontinued, the order shall not be effective until thirty days after the date of its passage. This contract is accepted and approved by County Judge, Edward Harper as per authorization by the Commissioners court, June 26th, 35. to execute papers as recommended by said Extension service.
