
The Commissioner's Court met in Special Session, August 4th, 1933, with Edward Harper, County Judge, H.E. White, Commr. Prec. No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commr. Prec. No. 2, P.H. McGowan, Commr. Prec. No. 3, Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, and transacted the following business, to-wit:

Whereas, it has come to the attention of the Commissioners' court of Sabine County, Texas, in Special Session on this the 4th day of August, 1933, that the State Highway Department will order a location made on highway No. 8, from Jasper-Sabine County line to Bronson, provided Sabine County, through its Commissioners' court, agrees to secure a minimum of 100 foot right-of-way clear of all obstructions, except standing timber, and furnish without cost to the State, clear title to the necessary right-of-way, including all standing timber, through each and every tract crossed by said highway, and to do the fencing, on location approved by the State highway Engineer, before said location is made.

It is, therefore, ordered byat Sabine County, acting, herein by and through its commissioner's Court agrees and obligates itself, to secure a minimum of 100 foot right-of-way and do the fencing on highway No. 8, from Jasper-Sabine County Line to Bronson and to clear such right-of-way of all obstructions, except standing timer, and furnish a clear title to each parcel secured, including all standing timber, without cost to the state, through each and every tract crossed by this highway on location to be approved by the State Highway Engineer.

Accounts were approved as account ledger.

There being no further business, court is adjourned.
