

The Honorable Commissioners Court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Special Session August 19th, 1933, with the following members present to-wit: Edw. Harper, County Judge, H. E. White, Commr. Prec. No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commr. Prec. No. 2, P. H. McCown, Commr. Prec. No. 3, R. W. Chapman, Commr. Prec. No. 4, Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, and transacted the following business, to-wit:

Accounts were allowed as per accounts ledger.

The Bond of Fred M. Cliphant, as Licensed State Land Surveyor, is approved, by the order of the court, duly had and carried.

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court, that scrip in the amount of \$172.50 be issued out of the P. I. Current Expense fund, for a typewriter. Said motion made by R. W. Chapman, second by E. C. Smith, and vote being unanimous.

The returns of an election of the assumption of bonds and tax for same were canvassed and the following order made.

ORDER DECLARING RESULTS OF ELECTION FOR ASSUMPTION OF BONDS:

On this day came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 12th day of August, 1933, in Consolidated Common School District No. 17, of this County, upon the question as to whether the said district shall assume and pay off the outstanding bonds heretofore issued by the Rosevine Dist. #17, and Sand Hill Dist. # 30, and School Districts, the said bonds being described as follows: Refunding Bonds. and levy a tax on all taxable property of said district sufficient to pay the current interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund sufficient to pay the principal at maturity, and it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made and that there were cast at said election 14 votes, of which number there were cast; For the assumption of the Bonds and the Tax, 14 votes. Against the assumption of the Bonds and the Tax, 0 votes.

And it appearing to the court from said returns that all of the qualified property tax-paying voters of said district, voting at said election, voted in favor of assuming the said bonds and the tax, the court does hereby declare the proposition for the assumption of said bonds to have been adopted, and that this court is authorized to levy and have assessed and collected said tax.
