

The Honorable Commissioner Court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Regular Session, August 28th, 1933, with the following members present, to-wit: Edward Harper, County Judge, H. E. White, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commissioner Precinct No. 2, P. H. McGown, Commissioner Precinct No. 3, R. W. Chamman, Commissioner Precinct No. 4, and transacted business as follows, to-wit:

On motion by E. C. Smith, second by H. E. White, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that the written resignation of W. N. Garriott, be and the same is hereby accepted, and W. N. Garriott is hereby released from his duties as such Constable of Precinct No. 6 of Sabine County.

On motion by P. H. McGown, second by H. E. White, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that Script No. 6, in the amount of \$24.00, issued to E. B. Smith, out of the P. I. fund, for feeding prisoners, be cancelled and that scrip in lieu thereof, be issued out of the Gen. Co. fund, for the same amount and purpose.

On motion by P. H. McGown, second by H. E. White, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that W. E. Payne, be appointed Deputy Constable of Precinct No. 3, of Sabine County, and here is hereby appointed.

After considering the above bids, it is decided by the court no bids be accepted at this time.

On motion by P. H. McGown, and seconded by H. E. White, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that J. L. Payne, County Treasurer, be given credit for \$457.66, because of error of the previous treasurer in entering a weekly report of Tax Collector, in the month of December.

On motion by P. H. McGown, second by H. E. White, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that the Tax Collector, Ross Kanner, be authorized to collect Taxes on 13 acres of land on the Wm. Isaacs League, owned by Lillie Carter, at the value of \$4.50 per acre.

Whereas, there came on this day to be considered the returns of an election held on the 26th day of August, 1933, to determine whether or not the sale of beer, containing not more than three and two-tenths per centum (3.2%) of alcohol by weight shall be permitted or prohibited in said Sabine County.

Whereas, upon consideration of the returns of said election, it appears that the same was in all respects legally held, after due notice had been given, and that the said returns were duly and legally made and that there were cast at the said election 794 votes, of which number 405 votes were cast "For the sale of beer containing not more than three and two-tenths per centum (3.2%) of alcohol by weight" and 389 votes were cast "Against the sale of beer containing not more than three and two-tenths per centum (3.2%) of alcohol by weight," and

And whereas from said returns a majority of the votes were cast "For the sale of Beer containing not more than three and two-tenths per centum (3.2%) of alcohol by weight."

Therefore be it declared and ordered by the court of Sabine County, Texas, that the proposition "For the Sale of Beer Containing not more than three and two-tenths per centum (3.2%) of alcohol by weight" received a majority of the votes cast at said election, and it shall be lawful to manufacture, sell and distribute beer containing not more than three and two-tenths per centum (3.2%) of alcohol by weight, after the effective date of the law, and thereafter until such time as the qualified voters of said Sabine County may thereafter at a legal election

held for that purpose by a majority vote decided otherwise.
