Hyden, Deputy Sheriff, and transacted business as follows: On motion by H.E. White, second by P.H. McGown, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that the County Treasurer transfer \$150.00 from the special P. & D. fund to the Pendleton Ferry Fund.

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that the Bond of Fred M. Oliphant, Lixensed State Land surveyor, with additionas security, be and the same is hereby approved.

On motion duly hand and carried, it is ordered by the court that the Monthly reports of W. M. Honeycutt, and Edward Harper, be and the same are hereby, in all things approved.

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that Monthly report of E. F. McDonald, J.P. Prect. No. 2, be and the same is hereby in all things approved.

Whereas on August 28th, 1933, bids were received for the Construction of a Flat Boat at Pendleton, Sabine County, Texas, and the bid of L. G. Thomas, for \$45.00 was found to be the lowest responsible bid; it is therefore ordered by the court, that a contract for the construction of said flat boat be awarded to L. G. Thomas, upon his giving bond in the sum of \$100.00 for the faithful performance of the Contract.

This agreement entered into this 11 day of September, A. D. 1933, between L. G. Thomas and Sabine County, for the consideration herein after mentioned hereby agrees with Sabine County, that he will at his own proper charge and expense in good and workmanlike manner construct and complete for said Sabine County, one flat Boat according to specifications, agreed upon between said parties with such lumber and other materials as the said Sabine County shall provide for the same. And the said Sabine County, shall and does hereby agree to pay L. G. Thomas, the sum of \$45.00 upon the completion of said work. And the said Sabine County further agrees at its proper cost and expense to provide such lumber and other necessary material for the construction and completion of said flat boat and thereby cause no delay to said L. G. Thomas.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR FLAT BOAT:

Length of boat to be 45'. Width of boat to be 12' (outside to outside). Take to begin 8" back on Gunnels and tapered 10" at end. Heedblocks 10' X 12' oak. Streamers 6 pcs. 3 x 20 x 30, 5' spliced on length. 4 pcs. 3 x 20 x 24 for cross streamers. For bottom floor 1 1/2" X 6" center match 12' long of # 1, sap. Fot top floor 2' X 8' X 12' rough heart. Not to lap over 2" over top of gunnels. Rabbits on gunnerls to be nailed on 2X 6 oak. Banisters to e of 4" X 4" scanlings - All heart. All of the bottom to be coal tarred.

Whereas, by virtue of House bill # 122, as passed by the 43rd legislature, and approved by the Governor, May 11, 1933, it is provided that each County may levy one half (1/2) the license fee levied by the State for the manufacturing, sale, transportation, disposing, storing and distributing beer; Now therefore, upon the motion of H. E. White, and seconded by P. H. McGown, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court, that the following annual license fees be and the same are hereby assessed for Sabine County.

(a) Manufacture and sale by manufacturer,	\$250.00.
(b) General Distributor,	100.00.
(c) For a Local Distributor.	25.00.
(d) Retail Dealer,	50.00.
(e) Retail Dealer, in original container.	25.00.

On motion by H. E. White, seconded by E. C. Smith, with H. E. White, E. C. Smith, and Edw. Harper, Votine, for the order, and P. H. McGown and R. W. Chapman, voting against the order, it is ordered by the court that W. D. Powell, be allowed the sum of \$30.00 per month to do the

mechanical and repair work of the Court house and jail, and that said amount be paid out of the Permanent Improvement Fund. It is also agreed that should he need any help for the repair or upkeep of the court house and jail that he will employ and bear the expense of said helper.

Accounts were allowed; as shown by Minutes of Accounts allowed.

There being no further business, court adjourned.
