

The Commissioners' court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Special Session September 14th, 1933, with the following members present, to-wit: Edward Harper, County Judge, H.E. White, Commr. Prec. No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commr. Prec. No. 2, P.H. McGown, Commr. Prec. No. 3, R. W. Chapman, Commr. Prec. No. 4, and Zeda Davidson, county, Clerk and transacted business as follows:

Accounts were allowed as per account ledger.

Whereas, the former court on August 7th, 1931 purchased from J. D. Adams, Company one adjustable leaning wheel grader No. 22, but failed to make any payments or issue any warrants, for which they promise the sum of \$1478.16 and whereas as they have never made any payments and upon the offer of the Company to omit the accrued interest from the date of August 7, 1931, to the present, and upon motion by H.E. White, second by P.H. McGown, vote unanimous, the court hereby confirms the contract and agrees to issue warrants; and hereby order the Clerk to issue warrants, in payment of said grader, as follows: No. 1, \$494.16, due April 1, 1934, No. 2 for \$941.00 due Apr. 1st, 1935, and No. 3 for \$491.00 due April 1st, 1936. Said warrants to be issued on the Road and Bridge fund, with agreement to pay 5% interest from date until paid, with interest to be paid in a separate warrant when the warrants are paid.

There being no further business, court is adjourned.
