Precinct No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commr. Precinct No. 2, P.H. Mc'own, Commr. Precinct No. 3, R.W. Chapman, Commr. Precinct No. 4, and Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, and transacted business as follows:

On motion by H.E. White, asconded by E. C. Smith, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that Scrip # 387, in the sum of \$8.25, issued of A. W. Mitchell, and scrip in lieu thereof be issued out of the same fund, for the same purpose and in the sum of \$3.45 and \$4.80.

On motion by H.E. White, second by E. C. Smith, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that 40 acres of the Hy. Robertson survey, on the unrendered roll, for the year 1930, be reduced to \$5.00 per acre.

Gentlemen:

I herewith submit to you my account for Commissions of 10% per cent on the amount of \$2300.00 dollars, which I was able to get discharged and eliminated from the Indebtedness of Sabine County, Texas, with J.R. Phillipps Company, of Houston, Texas, wherein they agreed
