

The Commissioner's court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in regular session, November 27th, 1933, with the following members present to-wit: Edw. Harper, County Judge, H. E. White, P.H. McGown, Commr. Prec. No. 3, and R.W. Chapman, Commr. Prec. No. 4, Commr. Prec. No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commr. Prec. No. 2, and Zeda Davidson County Clerk, and transacted business as follows:

On motion by H. E. White, and second by E. C. Smith, it is ordered by the court that the three \$800.00 bonds of Ruddell Common School District No. 17, Sabine County, be exchanged for an equal amount of Refunding bonds of said District.

On motion by H.E. White, second by P.H. McGown, vote unanimous; it is ordered by the court that scrip # 195, 198, 241, 517, 588 and 240, issued to E. B. Smith, on the P.I. Fund, for Salary and Feeding Prisoners, be cancelled, and scrip in lieu thereof be issued in like amounts for the same purposes but on the General County Fund.

On motion by P.H. McGown, second by R. W. Chapman, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that one-half of the funds derived from the beer licenses be placed to the credit of the General County emergency fund, and that the County Treasurer be authorized to register and pay off the same as it is presented, according to its registration number.

On motion by R. W. Chapman, second by H. E. White, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the Court that the following amounts be allowed Tax Assessor, A. G. Pratt, on the respective funds, for Tax Commission, for the year 1933. General County fund: \$ 128.71. Permanent Improvement \$128.72. Road - Bridge, \$77.22. Jury, \$77.23. County Wide, \$411.88. Road Dist. 1. \$8.63., Road District No. 2, \$7.35. Road Dist. 3, \$24.61. Road Dist. # 4, \$12.26. Road Dist. # 5, \$8.16, Road Dist. 6, \$6.19. Road Dist. No. 7, \$1.61. Road Distr. No. 9, \$4.99, Road Dist. # 10, \$72.03, Road Dist. No. 12, \$6.63., and Road District No. 13, \$ x.93.

On motion by H. E. White, second by E. C. Smith, vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that the following petition be, and the same is in all hereby granted:
TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

To the Honorable Commissioner's court of Sabine County.

The undersigned hereby petitions your body to annex to the Geneva Hog law district the following described territory; Beginning at the North corner of line between Henry P. Conn and Frank Conn; Thence to South to the Memphis and San Augustine road; Thence Easterly direction down said road to the C. D. White corner; Thence South to Tebo creek; Thence down said creek one Hundred Yards; Thence North to the said Memphis and San Augustine road; Thence in an north westerly direction to Pologoch creek; Thence up said creek to the place of bebinning, so as to include Hundred Nine and Three Fifths acres. (109-3/5) of land.
