
The Commissioners' court in and for Sabine County, met in Regular Session February 12th, 1934, with all members presents, to-wit: Edw. Harper, County Judge, H.E. White, Commr. Prect. No. 1, E.C. Smith, Commr. Prect. No. 2, P.H. McGown, Commr. Prect. No. 3, R.W. Chapman, Commr. Prect. No. 4, Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, and transacted business, as follows:

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that scrip in the sum of \$15.00 issued to H.J. McNaughten, No. 1629, be cancelled and scrip in lieu thereof be issued out of the same fund, for the same purpose but in sums of \$9.76, and \$5.24.

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On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that Scrip in the sum of \$25.00 issued to W.R. Hyden, be cancelled and scrip in lieu thereof, be issued for the same purpose on the same fund, but in amounts of \$21.60 and \$3.40.

On motion by P.H. McGown, seconded by R.W. Chapman, with Chapman and McGown, voting Aye, and White, No., it is ordered by the court that there be appointed by the court and be authorized by the court, to acquire right-of-way on Highway No. 8, from Jasper County Line to the North City Limits of the City of Bronson, by an officer to individual land owners, of a sum of money not to exceed that estimated by the Resident Engineer of the State Highway Department of Texas.

On motion by Chapman, second by H.E. White, it is ordered by the court that the County Court Convene on the Fourth Monday in May, the Third Monday in August and the 4th Monday in November, of the year 1934.

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that the Tax Collector, be, and he is hereby authorized to refund the sum of \$1.50, on taxes assessed against G.L. McLemore, on the W. Coley league of 32 acres, on the account of an error in assessment, in School District No. 4, instead of School District No. 29.

On motion by P.H. McGown, second by H.E. White, with a vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that the County Treasurer, be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to Transfer the sum of \$76.72, from the Special R. & B. Fund, to the Pendleton Ferry Fund, to take up outstanding scrip against said fund.

On motion by H.E. White, and seconded by R. W. Chapman, it was ordered by the court that \$1400.00 of the Permanent School Fund be invested in Sabine County Special Road 5 1/2 % bonds, series of 1918, maturing in 1948.

On motion by R.W. Chapman, second by H.E. White, it is ordered by the court that the Tax Collector be and he is hereby authorized to correct the rolls in collecting taxes of property Rendered by Livingston Grain & Grocery Co. by collecting on a valuation of \$100.00 instead of \$1000.00 as it appears on the roll, and which is an error in assessment.

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that the Tax Collector, be, and he is hereby authorized to correct taxes on roll rendered by E.T. McNaughten, in making his homestead on the G.L. Bourland instead of the A.W. Canfield, which was an error in assessment.

On motion by H.E. White, second by P.H. McGown, it is ordered by the court that the following petition be, and the same is hereby in all things granted.

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SABINE COUNTY:

We, the undersigned persons, owners of the hereinafter described lands, which adjoin lands on the West side in which a stock law now prevails and in which hogs, sheep, and goats are not permitted to run at large, hereby petition your honorable body to include the following lands and territory in said Stock law territory and that you pass an order extending the stock law forbidding the running at large of hogs, sheep and goats in such territory, said territory being described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the junction of Tebo and Pologocho creeks, being the East corner of the C.L. Arnold farm on the Wright Coley survey, thence up the Tebo creek with its meanders to the Northwest corner of the C.T. Whittlesey 150 acres on the Wright Coley survey; Thence South with the West line of the C.T. Whittlesey 150 acres to his S.W. corner; Thence East About 630 yds. to C.T. Whittlesey's S.E. corner; Thence South 1229 yds. to corner on E.B. line of Wright Coley survey; Thence S. 10 W. to the S.E. corner of the Wright Coley survey; Thence West with the South line of the Coley survey and the South line of the Temple 335 acres to the S.W. corner of said Temple 335 acres; Thence North with the W.B. line of said Temple 335 acres to the S.E. corner of the Bobbie Butler and Elton Butler lands; thence following the South line of the Bobbie Butler

and Elton Butler lands to their S.W. corner on the Wm. Clark league; Thence North with Butler's West line, and J.F. Clark's West line to the Tebo creek, Thence down Tebo creek with its meanders to the S.W. corner of the Wiley Griffin farm now owned by P.M. Coussons; Thence North with the West line of the Coussons farm to the Pologoch creek; Thence down Pologoch creek with its meanders to the place of beginning.
