On motion by P.H. McGown, seconded by H.E. White, is ordered by the court that A.G. Pratt, Tax Assessor, be allowed the sum of \$100.00, out of the General County "BW" fund as advance on fees for assessment County Taxes.

On motion by P.H. McGown, seconded by E.C. Smith, it is ordered by the court that The Co. Treasurer, Roy Payne, quarterly report be, and it is hereby in all things approved.

Accounts were allowed as is shown by account ledger.

There being no further business court is adjourned.
