On motion duly had and carried it is ordered by the court that the Monthly report of W. M. Honeycutt, and Edward Harper, Be and they are hereby approved.

Upon hearing the testimony of the sworn witnesses, the laws and facts as was presented to the court, and the motion and second with a vote unanimous in favor of said motion, it is hereby declared by the court that the Road from Memphis, via the residence of Sam Davidson, to intersect the public road at Geo. Colliers, is a public road and should be kept open, and that such obstructions as are now placed in said road should be moved therefrom.

There being no further business, court is adjourned.
