

The Commissioner's court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Special Session July 21 1934 with all members present, to-wit: Edw. Harper, County Judge, H.E. White, Commr. Prec. No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commr. Prec. No. 2, P.H. McGown, Commr. Prec. No. 3, R.W. Chapman, Commr. Prec. no. 4. and Zeds Davidson, County Clerk, and transacted business, as follows, to-wit:

accounts were allowed as is shown by account ledger.

On motion made by E. C. Smith, seconded by H. E. White, with a vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that the Tax Assessor, A.G. Pratt, be allowed \$100.00 for Clerical hire and expenses for assessing taxes, for the year of 1934, issued out of the County Wide Fund.

On motion by H. E. White, seconded by R. W. Chapman, with a vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court, that 200 acres of land on the John Gilbert survey Abstract No. 18, owned by W.E. Carlton, be exempted as a homestead, and the Tax Collector be, and he is hereby authorized to accept taxes on same as such homestead.

On motion made by P.H. McGown, seconded by R. W. Chapman, with a vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that to clear the right-of-way in the construction of highway No. 8, through a portion of the A.Cts. Nos. 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15, in the town of Bronson, that \$150.00 of the Special Right of way fund be held in escrow pending receipt of release from Great Southern Life Insurance Company. Final payment for which will come through the State highway department Loan Fund.

There being no further business, court is adjourned.
