Russell, Sheriff and Zeda Davidson, Clerk, and transacted business as follows, to-wit:

Accounts were allowed and approved as is shown by account ledger.

Monthly reports of W. M. Honeycutt, and Edward Harper, were duly approved by motion and second by the court, with a vote unanimous.

Whereas, information has been received from State highway Commission that further road work in Sabine County will be suspended until such time as the right-of-way on Highway No. 8, Bronson South to Jasper County Line, has been secured. On motion of P. H. McGown, seconded by R. W. Chapman, with a vote unanimous, it is hereby ordered by the court in regular session on this 10th day of September, 1934, that the following be placed on the minutes of Sabine County Commissioners' court; Upon an advancement of \$6000.00 credit from the State highway Commission to Sabine County, for the purpose of right-of-way on highway No. 8, Bronson South to Jasper County, line, Sabine County will repay to the State highway Commission out of the regular Road & Bridge fund \$6000.00, at such time as this fund will bear this expenditure.

There being no further business, court is adjourned.
