

The Commissioners' court in and for Magine County, Texas, met in Regular session, September 24th, 1934, with all members present, to-wit: Edw. Harper, County Judge, H.E. White, Commr. Prec. No. 1, E.C. Smith, Commr. Prec. No. 2, P.H. McGown, Commr. Prec. No. 3, R. W. Chapman, Commr. Prec. No. 4, Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, and Zeda Davidson, Clerk and transacted business as follows:

Accounts were allowed and approved as is shown by account ledger.

On motion made by E. C. Smith, seconded by R. W. Chapman, with a vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that the written resignation presented the court, by Ross Kenner, Tax Collector, be and the same is hereby accepted, to take effect on October 1st, 1934 as ask for in the resignation.

After considering the applicants, J. J. Cammack, Lum Woods, N. W. Ener and W. C. Rice, the court cast a secrete ballot, in the appointment of a Tax Collector to fill the vacancy made by the resignation of Ross Kenner. On canvassing the returns of the secret vote, it was found that N. W. Ener receive two votes and W. C. Rice received two votes, with Judge Edward Harper voting for N.W. Ener in breaking the tie; N.W. Ener is hereby declared appointed to full the unexpired term of Ross Kenner, upon his making sufficient bond for same.

There being no further business, court is adjourned.
