

The Commissioners' court in and for Sabine County, met in Special Session November 20th, 1954, with the following members present to-wit: Edw. Harper, County Judge, P.H. McGown, Commr. Prec. 3, and R.W. Chapman, Commr. Prec. No. 4, Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, and Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, and transacted business as follows:

Accounts were allowed and approved as is shown by account ledger.

On motion made by P.H. McGown, seconded by R.W. Chapman, it is ordered by the court that the 25¢ County Poll Tax levied by the County, be placed to the credit of the General County Emergency Fund.

Whereas, the Legislature has seen fit to remit all interest and penalties on delinquent taxes due the State and Counties by virtue of H.B. N. 7, but it appears that said remission does not become affective until February 9, 1955, and it further appears to be for the best interest of the County that the same become affective as to the County's part immediately. On motion made by Chapman, seconded by McGown, it is ordered by the Commissioners' court that all penalties and interests as to the County's part be remitted, and the Tax Collector is hereby authorized to accept tax payments with penalties and interest on the County's portion remitted.

There being no further business, court is adjourned.
