

The Commissioners' Court, in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Regular Session December 17th, 1934, with all members present to-wit: Edw. Harper, County Judge, H. E. White, Commr. Precinct No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commr. Precinct No. 2, P. H. McEown, Commr. Precinct No. 3, R. W. Chapman, Commr. Precinct No. 4, Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, and Zeda Davidson, Clerk and transacted business as follows, to-wit:

Accounts were allowed and approved as is shown by accounts allowed.

On motion made by P. H. McEown, seconded by E. C. Smith, it is ordered by the court that the Depository's Report of School Funds, made by First National Bank of San Augustine, be and the same is hereby in all things approved.

On motion duly had and carried it is ordered by the court that the Monthly and Quarterly reports of W. M. Honeycutt, and Zeda Davidson, be and the same are hereby approved.

Whereas, the State of Texas has offered to take over and beautify for Park purposes, without cost to the County, that certain ten (10) acre tract of land situated in Sabine County and on the John Clark survey, conveyed to Sabine County for a County Park, by deed dated May 15 1930, by Kirby Lumber Company, and recorded in Volume # 33, page 551, Deed Records of Sabine County, Texas; and said offer appearing to be for the best interest of the county, and upon motion of R. W. Chapman, and seconded by E. C. Smith, by unanimous vote it was ordered that Edward Harper, County Judge, be authorized, and he is here by directed to execute proper deed of conveyance to the State or agent of the State to the above described premises for the purposes and consideration aforesaid.

On this day came to be considered the Petition of F. W. Oliphint, and 20 others, asking that the public road leading from the town of Memphis to Sam Davidson's be chanced, together with a protest to said petition signed by E. P. Padgett, and Sam Davidson. H. E. White made a motion for said petition to be granted, and there was no second, or no vote had. Therefore the petition was not granted.

There being no further business, court is adjourned.

ORDER APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR COOPERATIVE EXTENSION WORK IN AGRICULTURE AND HOME ECONOMICS,  
UNDER AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF SENATE BILL NUMBER 82, PASSED BY THE 40th TEXAS LEGISLATURE, 1927.

State of Texas  
County of Sabine

Commissioners' court of Sabine County, in session December term, A.D.  
1934.

It is ordered by the Commissioners' court of Sabine County that the sum of \$1,000.00) one  
Thousand Dollars be appropriated and the same is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the  
County to be used as part salary for a County Agricultural and Mechanical College of Texas.

This appropriation shall become available on December 14th, 1934, or as soon thereafter as  
the Extension Service of the A. and M. College of Texas shall place an agent in said county for  
duty, and shall be paid out in monthly installments to said agent upon written order duly sign-  
ed by an authorized representative of said Extension service.

This appropriation shall continuous annually until the Commissioners' court or the Exten-  
sion service of the A. and M. College of Texas shall decide to discontinue same, and the order  
of discontinuance shall be passed only during the month of December, which time will be near  
the close of the season and the years' work. Otherwise this order and agreement shall remain  
in effect from year to year. The Commissioners' court or the Extension service of the A. and  
M. College of Texas shall give notice in writing to the other cooperating agency at least thirty  
days prior to any official action pertaining to the discontinuance of the work in the County.  
In the event the work is discontinued, the order shall not be effective until thirty days after  
the date of its passage.
