

On November 7, 1934 an election was held in Sabine County, to determine whether the sale of beer should be permitted or prohibited; and the results showed a majority against the sale of beer and I as County Judge duly issued order proclaiming same.

I therefore announce and proclaim that the above named order was properly published for four consecutive weeks, on November 30, December 7, December 14, and December 21, 1934, in the Sabine County reporter, a weekly newspaper, published regularly at Hemphill, Texas, and that the above number of times constituted the required publication as proclaimed by law for

such orders.
