

The Commissioner's Court, in and for Sabine County, Texas, met in Regular Session February 11th, 1935, with the following members present, to-wit: Edw. Harper, County Judge, T. R. Smith, Commr. Prec. No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commr. Prec. No. 2, P. H. McGown, Commr. Prec. No. 3, R. W. Chapman, Commr. Prec. No. 4, Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, and Zeda Davidson, Clerk and transacted business, as follows, to-wit:

On motion by R. W. Chapman, seconded by T. R. Smith, it is ordered by the court that Scrip No. issued to Harvey Bradshaw, on the R & B. Fund, in the sum of \$21.00, be cancelled, and

scrip in lieu thereof, be issued out of the same fund, for the same purpose, but in sums of \$5.92 and \$15.08.

That scrip of the sum of \$46.00 issued to H. L. Travis, on the R & B. Fund, be cancelled, and scrip for the same purpose, on the same fund, but in the sum of \$21.00 and \$25.00 be issued.

That scrip of W. R. Hyden's in the sum of \$25.00, on the Gen. Co. Fund, be cancelled, and scrip in lieu thereof, be issued out of the same fund, for the same purpose but in the sum of \$5.48 and \$19.52.

That Scrip No. 454, issued to J. D. Baldrée, on the R & B. Fund, in the amount of \$17.78 be cancelled, and scrip in lieu thereof, be issued out of the same fund, for the same purpose but in the sums of \$6.88, \$4.35, \$4.50 and \$2.05.

On this day came on to be considered the various bids for work in removing houses from the right-of-way on Highway No. 8, and after considering all of the bids received, it is the opinion of the Court, that the bid of L. P. Beasley, is the best and lowest bid received. It is therefore ordered by the court that they enter into a contract with the said L. P. Beasley, to remove the houses off said right-of-way.

On this day came on to be considered the Bids for County Depository for Sabine County, and it appearing to the court that there was only one bid made for said depository, it being that of the First National Bank of San Augustine, Texas. On motion by P. H. McGown, seconded by T. R. Smith, with a vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court, that the following bid of the First National Bank of San Augustine, be and the same is hereby accepted.
