On motion made by R. W. Chapman, seconded by P. H. McGown, it is ordered by the court that Scrip No. 1682, in favor of Hempvill Motor Company, in the sum of \$285.00, on the Gen. Co. Cur. Ex. Smith, with a vote unanimous in favor of the motion, Subject to the provisions to be attached to the original contract, it is ordered by the court that Sabine County, by and through its Commissioners' Court, enter into a contract with C. D. Jessup Jr., for the purpose of collecting delinquent taxes due the county.
