

The Commissioners' court met in Regular session June 24th, 1934, with all members present, to-wit: Edw. Harper, County Judge, T. R. Smith, Commr. Prect. No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commr. Prect. No. 2, P.H. McGown, Commr. Prect. No. 3, R. W. Chapman, Commr. Prect. No. 4, Geo. W. Russell, sheriff, and Zeda Davidson, Clerk, and transacted business as follows:

Accounts were allowed and approved, as is shown by minutes of accounts allowed.

On this day came on to be heard the complaint of Willis Conner, complaining that the Road which was purported to be a public road leading from J.H.
