
The Commissioners' court met in Special Session July 15th, 1935, with the following members present, to-wit: Edw. Harper, County Judge, T. R. Smith, Commr. Prect. No. 1, P.H. McGown, Commr. Prect. No. 3, R. W. Chapman, Commr. Prect. No. 4, Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, and Zeda Davidson, clerk and transacted business as follows, to-wit:

Accounts were allowed and approved as is shown by minutes of Accounts allowed:

On motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the court that Scrip No. 1866, issued to

E.C. Smith, in the sum of \$93.34, out of the Gen. Co. "B" fund be cancelled and scrip in lieu thereof be issued, as follows: \$70.00 out of the Gen Co. "B" fund for the same purposes, and \$23.34 out of the Road & Bridge Current Expense fund. That Scrip No. 1864 issued to P.H. McGown, in the sum of \$93.34 be cancelled and scrip in lieu thereof be issued in the amounts and fund as follows: \$70.00 out of the Gen. Co. "B" fund and \$23.34 out of the R & B. Cur. Ex. fund.

Upon motion of T.R. Smith, Seconded by R.W. Chapman, the following order was unanimously adopted: "I move that this court submit to the State Highway Department and to the United States Bureau of Public Roads, the urgent necessity of designing bridge structures for a four-lane traffic on all new permanent locations on highway Number Eight of Texas, inasmuch as the amount of travel which is beginning to develop through the partial paving of this highway suggests this as a need for the future from the standpoint of safety and demands for highway transportation".
