The Commissioners, court met in Special Session November 29th, 1935; with the following smembers present to wit: Edw. Harper, County Judge, T. R. Smith, Commr. Prect. No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commr. Prect. No. 2, R. W. Chapman, Coumr. Prect. No. 4, Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, and Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, and transacted business as follows, to-wit:

The Following order was passed and signed by the Commissioners' court.

Whereas, it has come to the attention of the Commissioners' court of

Sabine County, Texas, in Special Session on this the 29 day of November, 1935, that the State Highway Department will order a location made on Highway No. McMahon Chapel Road, from State Highway No. 21, to Mamahon Chapel provided Sabine County, through its Commissioners' court, agrees to secure a minimum of 100 foot right-of-way, clear of all obstructions, except standing timber, and furnish without cost of the State, Clear title to the necessar right-of-way including all stanking timber, through each and every tract crossed by said Highway and to do the fencing, on location approved by the State Highway Engineer before said location is made.

It is, therefore, ordered that Sabine County, acting herein by and through its Commissioners' court, agrees and obligates itself to secure a minimum of 100 foot right-of-way, and do the fencing, on Highway No. McMahon Chapel road from State Highway No. 21, to McMahon Chapel and to clear such right-of-way of all obstructions, except standing timber, and furnish a clear title to each parcel secured, including all standing timber, without cost to the State, through each and every tract eressed by this Highway, on location to be approved by the State Highway Engineer.
