

Be it remembered that on the 8th day of April, A special called session of the Commissioners' court of Sabine County was held at the court house. Present and presiding Edw. Harper County Judge, Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, T. R. Smith, Commr. Prect. No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commr. Prect. No. 2, P.H. McGown, Commr. Prect. No. 3, R. W. Chapman, Commr. Prect. No. 4, when the following orders was unanimously adopted.

It is ordered that two cents of the 15% Ad Valorem taxes collected for Road and Bridge purposes be set aside in the Special Road & Bridge Funding Warrant fund to pay off the Funding Warrants issued in 1923.

It is further ordered that two cents of the 15% Ad Valorem taxes collected for Road and Bridge Purposes be set aside in the Bridge Repair Bond Fund to pay off the Funding Warrants issued in 1926.

It is further ordered that 11/15ths of the 15% Ad Valorem taxes collected for Road and Bridge purposes be set aside in the Fund to be designated SPECIAL ROAD AND BRIDGE FUNDING WARRANT FUND for the purpose of paying off the interest and creating a sinking fund to pay the principal and interest on Road and Bridge Funding Warrants Nos. 3 to 27 inc. for the sum of \$1000.00 each dated the 15th day of May, A. D. 1928, and referred to in the Judgment of the District Court of the United States for the Eastern District of Texas, Beaumont Division, (said Judgment hereinafter recorded) in suit No. 532, styled S. G. Gary, Plaintiff, vs. Sabine County, et al, which Judgment was dated March 26th, 1936, and that out of said fund the Treasurer pay the costs in said suit and then pay to the Plaintiff, S. G. Gary, the remainder of money in said last mentioned fund.

Accounts were allowed and approved as is shown by Minutes of accounts allowed.

There being no further business, court is adjourned.
