

The Commissioners' court met in Regular Session April 27th, 1936, with all members present to-wit: Edw. Harper, County Judge, T. R. Smith, Commr. Prect. No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commr. Prect. No. 2, P. H. McGown, Commr; Prect. No. 3, R. W. Chapman, Commr. Prect. No. 4, Geo. W. Russell, sheriff, and Zeda Davidson, Clerk and transacted business, as follows, to-wit:

Accounts were allowed and approved, as is shown by Minutes of accounts allowed:

Upon affidavit of T.A. White, that Scrip No. 1372 issued to him for bridge work on January 26, 1931, in the sum of \$22.50, was lost, and upon application for a duplicate of said scrip be issued, it is ordered by the court that such duplicate be issued and the original, if ever produced, be cancelled.

At a regular meeting of the Commissioners' court of Sabine County, Texas, held on the 27th day of Apr. 1936, upon motion of T. R. Smith, made in open court and seconded by P.H. McGown, it is ordered by the court that Edward Harper, County Judge, be authorized and empowered to execute for the County, a supplemental Agreement with Gulf, Colorado and Santa Fe Railway Company, providing for termination by mutual consent of that certain agreement between the parties, dated February 5, 1925, bearing Railway Company's Secretary's No. 14579, relating to construction, maintenance and operation of a seven hundred (700) foot spur track at steep creek, in said County as per copy recorded at the foot of this order.

MUTUAL TERMINATION AGREEMENT

Supplemental Agreement, made this 27th day of April, 1936, between, Gulf, Colorado and Santa Fe Railway Company, a Texas, corporation (hereinafter called the "Railway Company"), first party, and Sabine County, Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, acting herein by Edward Harper, its County Judge, (hereinafter called "County"), hereunto duly authorized by order of its Commissioners' court, certified copy of which is hereto attached, second party,

WITNESSETH:

It is mutually agreed that, the certain Agreement (GC&SF Secretary's No. 14579), dated February 5, 1925, between the Railway Company and Sabine County, Texas, relating to construction, maintenance and operation of a seven hundred (700) foot spur track, at steep Creek, San Augustine County, Texas, is hereby terminated as of April 15, 1936, such termination shall not release either of the parties hereto from any liability or obligation, whether of indemnity or otherwise, which may have attached or accrued previous to or which may be accruing at the time of such termination.
